

The Nine Mile Run Greenway Project Needs YOU!

Studies from across the country demonstrate that property values and quality of life increase with proximity to green space and recreational resources. The Nine Mile Run Greenway Project's innovative community involvement process is designed to broaden participation in the greening of the watershed we share. **Please participate in the discussion to improve your neighborhood.**

Important decisions will soon be made which will determine how we fulfill the potential, first identified one hundred years ago, to create an urban park. The Department of Environmental Protection recently issued an order to address sewer line violations to the four major watershed municipalities. How will the municipalities respond? In the spring, the Urban Redevelopment Authority will be seeking City Planning Commission approval of its Phase I Development Plan for Summerset at Frick. Grading may begin later in the spring. The brownfield's transformation is beginning and your ideas are needed.
